Flagger Safety & Traffic Control

Work on New York's roadways is one of the most hazardous of all construction occupations. This course is designed to discuss the hazards associated with worker exposure to vehicular traffic and temporary traffic control and give students the opportunity to practice flagging methods in a controlled environment. Upon completion of this course, students will be able to recognize the need to use specified equipment when performing flagging responsibilities, correctly execute the stop/proceed/slow directions, set up a flagger station to maximize their own safety, the safety of their crew and passing motorists as well as perform emergency flagging.
